Jesse is a 36-year-old first generation Cuban American who oversees all government related issues that pertain to the commercial and real estate industry on a local, state and federal level. Prior to his new private sector role, he served as the Deputy District Director for the United States House of Representatives in Congressional District 19, where he was the main liaison between Washington D.C. and SWFL.

Jesse is the Chairmen of the City of Bonita Springs Outreach Committee, he is a registered lobbyist for the Collier County Commission and he sits on the Board of Directors for the Hispanic Vote PAC of SWFL.

Under Jesse's leadership, NABOR was successful in fighting back the \$21 million dollar tax increase in form of the water surcharge Tax from the County. This is one of three multi-million dollar tax cuts since his arrival at NABOR totaling over 60 million dollars annually and in perpetuity on our industry.

Under the direction of Jesse Purdon, NABOR hosted both Congressman Mario Diaz- Balart and Congressman Francis Rooney for a "Community Water Update" on our current water quality issues.

Jesse has been appointed to the 2019 "Public Policy" committee on the state level of Florida Realtors, only three Government Affairs Directors in the state of Florida received this honor. Jesse has successfully gotten numerous initiatives across the finish line in both Lee and Collier Counties.
